SASKATOON OFFICIALS GET A SNEAK PEAK AT THE NEW GALAXY CINEMAS

Saskatoon, SK., Wednesday, June 21, 2006 (CGX.UN) – Saskatoon officials including Mayor Donald Atchison, City Council members and Saskatoon media had the chance to experience a true behind-the-scenes look at the construction of the City's newest entertainment complex at an exclusive construction tour held earlier today.

"Galaxy Cinemas Saskatoon is going to be an incredible entertainment complex," said Pat Marshall, Vice President, Communications & Investor Relations, for Cineplex Entertainment LP. "Saskatoon will now be getting a state-of-the-art, full stadium, 12-screen multiplex theatre with all the latest amenities. We have wanted to build in Saskatoon for several years and are delighted this project is now coming to fruition."

Galaxy Cinemas have proven to be destinations that attract local residents and visitors from far and wide, generating traffic that supports many businesses located near and around the theatre.

"Galaxy Cinemas Saskatoon is a great addition to our community, as it will attract people from our city and greater Saskatoon into our downtown," said Mayor Donald Atchison. "Not only does this new theatre complex bring new jobs, and an exciting new entertainment destination for residents of all ages, it will benefit local businesses by increasing foot traffic in the area."

The new cinema will cost approximately \$12 million for the building and equipment and has generated approximately 180 new construction jobs over the past eight-month building process. Ongoing, the theatre will employ approximately 80 permanent and seasonal part-time staff. "We create a number of new jobs when we enter a community -- short term on the construction-side and long-term when you include our theatre management and staff," said Marshall.

Galaxy Cinemas Saskatoon will feature 12 wall-to-wall, giant, curved screens; 2,454 large, luxurious, high-backed armchairs offering generous legroom in a stadium-style environment; and Dolby Digital Surround Sound. The lobby features a relaxing environment for get-togethers before or after the movie. Our concession bar will also offer more than just the traditional movie fare of popcorn and soft drinks. In addition to the broad snack and beverage selection, Galaxy Cinemas Saskatoon will also

feature Pizza Pizza, Outtakes and a Yogen Fruz frozen dessert bar with no fat and low fat yogurts, smoothies and premium ice creams. The lobby will also feature two birthday party rooms, as well as a Zero Gravity family entertainment centre featuring the latest interactive electronic video games.
