When: October 9th at 1 p.m. (local time)

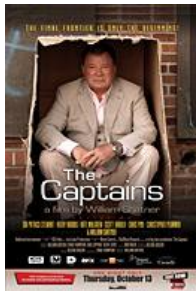

When: October 13th at 7:00 p.m. local time

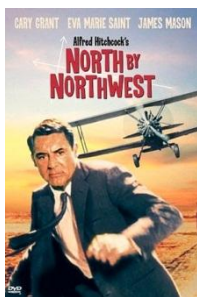
