Galaxy Cinemas Brantford named Canada's first LEED certified movie theatre

Toronto, ON, July 21, 2014 (TSX: CGX) – The Canadian Green Building Council recently named *Galaxy Cinemas Brantford* the first LEED certified movie theatre in Canada.

The LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) rating system is recognized as the international mark of excellence for environmentally sustainable building practices in more than 132 countries. LEED considers many factors in its assessment, including access to public transportation, energy performance, CO2 monitoring, and waste control, among others.

"We are proud to be recognized for our approach to constructing and operating *Galaxy Cinemas Brantford*," said Ellis Jacob, President and CEO, Cineplex Entertainment. "We look forward to serving our guests in one of North America's most sustainably constructed and operated movie theatres for years to come."

Galaxy Cinemas Brantford was built with reduced construction waste, and used regionally manufactured and extracted materials to reduce the carbon footprint created during the construction process. Cineplex finished the theatre with the use of low emission materials, such as low VOC paints and carpets.

Movie-goers at *Galaxy Cinemas Brantford* will notice many of the building's environmentally friendly features, such as low flow plumbing fixtures, which reduce water use by as much as 43 per cent, and energy efficient lighting. A special white roof and building automation significantly reduce the theatre's energy consumption. The theatre also takes an innovative approach to recycling, storage and collection – reducing the amount of waste sent to landfill.

In June, Brantford Power awarded Galaxy Cinemas Brantford a Conservation Certificate of Recognition Award, in acknowledgment of the theatre's commitment to energy reduction.

Galaxy Cinemas Brantford is cleaned exclusively with green-certified cleaning products. Cineplex has also made efforts to educate guests about the importance of sustainable living, broadcasting a short presentation prior to feature films and in lobby ads.
