That same weekend, on Saturday, September 30, 2006, *Galaxy Cinemas Saskatoon* will host a morning of FREE movies and specially priced, \$2.00 popcorn and soft drinks with all concession proceeds being donated to the CHHF. The lobby will be filled with fun all morning. From face-painting and clowns to candy company mascots and snack food sampling - everyone is invited to come out to support *Community Day for the CHHF*.

"This will be a fun and very special morning for families in Saskatoon," said Marshall. "All the movies are *free of charge* to guests and are based on seat availability on a first

Starting Friday, September 1, 2006 *Galaxy Cinemas Saskatoon* will open its doors to the public. On the same day, Cineplex Odeon Pacific Cinemas will also close its doors. A family entertainment centre will offer a number of interactive video games and activities and is accessible without the purchase of a movie ticket.
