TORONTO, Ontario. October 20, 2004, (TSX: CGX.UN): Cineplex Galaxy LP is extremely pleased to announce the opening of our newest Galaxy Cinema will be on Friday, November 5, 2004 at 6:00 p.m. The theatre is located at 865 West Ridge Boulevard.

“We are so delighted to be opening our 22<sup>nd</sup> Galaxy Cinema in Orillia,” said Pat Marshall, Vice President, Communications for Cineplex Galaxy LP, owners of the theatre. “The Orillia and Simcoe County area residents have been tremendously supportive of us and eager to learn of the theatre’s opening date so we decided to make the announcement today,” Marshall said. “We will have a great line up of films for our opening weekend that everyone will enjoy.”

The new cinema will cost approximately \$5 million for the building and equipment and has created more than 100 new construction jobs during the past six month building process. Ongoing, the theatre will employ approximately 50 permanent and seasonal part-time staff. “When you hear the name Galaxy, most people think of movies and fun which is great. They generally don’t think of the really positive economic impact the arrival of our theatres have in a community both in the short term with construction jobs and in the longer term with our theatre management and staff,” said Marshall.

We are also very pleased to announce the appointment of Rob Chatarpaul to the position of General Manager, and the appointment of Graham Holloway to the position of Operations Manager for Galaxy Cinemas Orillia. Rob was most recently Operations Manager at our Cineplex Odeon Grande Theatre in Barrie. Graham was a manager at our Galaxy Cinemas in Waterloo. Dozens of local residents were hired over the past few weeks following our very successful Job Fair.

The new Galaxy Cinemas Orillia will feature six, all stadium seated auditoriums (each seat row will be 18” higher than the previous row), wall-to-wall giant curved screens, large, luxurious seats with ample legroom, Digital Surround Sound and state-of-the-art projection systems. The entire complex is wheelchair accessible and seats more than 1095 people. The spacious lobby features a Zero Gravity Family Entertainment Centre featuring the latest in electronic video games and can be accessed without a movie ticket.
